What are the member and playing fees and when can I play?

While we are a welcoming club, we don't want to rush you into membership. To begin to get to know the club and its members, we encourage new players to pay the one-off visitor fee of \$10 per visit for a while to get to know the club, its members and see if we are a good fit for you. You can also hire a table for \$15 per hour or pre-book a table for \$20 per hour and play with friends.

I play table tennis at home, at work, or with my friends and want to play competition. How do I start competition play?

The club plays competition on three nights. Friday, Wednesday and Tuesday. New to competition players are encouraged to show interest in playing on a Friday night. Players who have previously played club competition, meet special criteria such as having a valid Ratings Central rating or have played high level club competition elsewhere may show interest in either our Wednesday night competition or our premier level pennant night (Tuesday).

Applications for competition play are accepted towards the end of each season for the following season. Places are not guaranteed and subject to available and club selection processes. Registration typically starts two weeks before the end of the previous season and is advertised on our website.

I am over 50 and just want a social hit. When is a good time for me?

The club runs *Keenager sessions* for over 50's on Tuesdays and Fridays from 9.30am to 12.30pm for just \$5 a visit. Membership is also available if you choose.

I am under 18 and would like some coaching. When should I come to the club?

The club runs a specific junior practice/coaching session on Thursdays between 5.00 and 7.30pm for just \$5 per junior. The club also has a High Performance junior program as well as a Junior Development Squad that are made available to talented juniors on an invitation basis.

Is the club COVID-19 safe?

The club takes its COVID-19 obligations and responsibilities very seriously and expects its visitors and members comply with all conditions of entry. We have a COVID Safe Plan and have implemented many COVID Safe processes including the cleaning all commonly touched surfaces and tables to ensure the safe participation of all. We require visitors and members to sign in on entry using the contactless solutions available or alternatively using the paper and pen register. If you show any signs of sickness, we ask you do not attend the club and seek a COVID-19 test as soon as possible.
